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FOREWORD

Kind reader:

I humbly intend to fulfil what the Lord teaches in Psalm 71:18 (p. 20), that his mighty power should be spoken of to the generation to come.

Since life for most of us means that we do not have the time to read the Bible in its entirety, I have selected those Bible verses which, in my humble opinion, are perhaps most interesting for ordinary people like me. Let them guide us in the days God has given us, so that we may do the right thing – which is God's will – and so that we may attain everlasting life.

As they are reliable truths, I have kept the biblical order, proving that the biblical sequence and coherence are perfect and inspired by the Holy Spirit.

After reading the Holy Scriptures, I have deduced that our Lord Jesus Christ, as the perfect man that he was, was baptised at almost 30 years of age in the Jordan River by the hands of St. John the Baptist. After that he was BORN AGAIN, as God's approved son. Like Jesus Christ, all of us can also BE BORN AGAIN in this life.

In the Gospel of the Apostle John, in verses 3:3-7 (p. 48) Christ says: "No one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again. No one can enter the kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. You must be born again".

In verse 2:38 (p. 50) of the Acts of the Apostles, St. Peter says: "Repent and be baptised, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit".

In Paul's Epistle to the Ephesians, verse 4:24 (p. 59), we are told: "Put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness".

In Paul's First Epistle to Timothy, verse 6:12 (p. 65), we are exhorted to fight the good fight of the faith and to take hold of the eternal life to which we are called.

In Paul's Epistle to Titus, verses 3:5-7 (p. 66) we are told that God saved us because of his mercy through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit whom he poured out on us generously through Jesus Christ, so that we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.

In the First Epistle of Peter, verse 1:3 (p. 70) tells us that God has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead. Verses 1:23 and 2:2 (p. 70) show that we have been given a new birth through the living and enduring word of God, and that as newborn babies, we must crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it we may grow up in our salvation.

For all these reasons, I wish to convey to you that it is worthwhile to heed the word of the Lord.

7:23 — I see in my body another law warring against the law of my mind and leading me captive to sin's law that is in my body.

7:24 — Miserable man that I am! With the mind I serve the spirit, but with the flesh I serve sin. Who will rescue me from the body undergoing this death?

7:25 — I myself in my mind am a slave to God's law, but in my sinful nature a slave to the law of sin.

8:5 — Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires.

8:6 — The mind governed by the flesh is death, but the mind governed by the Spirit is life and peace.

8:13 — If you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live.

8:14 — Those who are led by the Spirit of God are the children of God, and therefore heirs of God.

8:38-39 — Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord.

9:15 — God will have mercy on whom he will have mercy, and he will have compassion on whom he will show compassion.

12:20 — If your enemy is hungry, feed him; if he is thirsty, give him something to drink.

12:21 — Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good.

13:7 — Give to everyone what you owe them.

13:8 — Do not owe anything to anyone except to love one another.

13:9 — Love your neighbour as yourself.

13:13 — Let us behave decently, as in the daytime, not in

carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and debauchery, not in dissension and jealousy.

13:14 — Do not think about how to gratify the desires of the flesh.

14:8 — If we live, we live for the Lord; and if we die, we die for the Lord. So, whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord.

14:12-13 — Each of us will render an account for himself to God. Therefore, let us not judge one another any longer.

14:17 — The kingdom of God means righteousness and peace and joy with Holy Spirit.

14:21 — It is better not to eat meat or drink wine or to do anything else that will cause your brother or sister to fall.

10:24 — No one should seek their own good, but the good of others.

13:11 — When you are a child you talk like a child, you think like a child, you reason like a child; when you become a man you must cease to do so.

13:13 — These three remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.

14:20 — Stop thinking like children. In regard to evil be infants, but in your thinking be adults.

15:32 — Let us eat and drink, for tomorrow we die.

15:33 — Bad company corrupts good habits.

15:58 — Be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that your labour is not in vain in the Lord.

SECOND EPISTLE TO THE CORINTHIANS

4:16 — Though outwardly we are wasting away, yet inwardly we are being renewed day by day.

5:20 — Be reconciled to God.

7:1 — Let us purify ourselves from everything that contaminates body and spirit, perfecting holiness out of reverence for God.

7:10 — Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death.

9:7 — God loves a cheerful giver.

10:17 — Let the one who boasts boast in the Lord.

12:14 — Children should not have to save up for their parents, but parents for their children.

EPISTLE TO THE GALATIANS

1:10 — If you please men, you do not please God.

3:11 — The righteous will live by faith.

5:13 — Serve one another humbly in love.

5:19-21 — The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions,

factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like.

5:22-23 — But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control.

6:7 — God cannot be mocked. A man reaps what he sows.

6:8 — Whoever sows to please their flesh, from the flesh will reap destruction; whoever sows to please the Spirit, from the Spirit will reap eternal life.

6:9 — Let us not become weary in doing good, for at the proper time we will reap a harvest if we do not give up.

EPISTLE TO THE EPHESIANS

2:4 — God, who is rich in mercy.

3:17 — Through your faith you may have Christ dwell in your hearts with love.

3:19 — May we be filled with all the fullness of God.

4:2 — Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love.

4:22 — Put away your former way of life, your old self which is being corrupted by its deceitful desires.

4:23-24 — Be made new in the attitude of your mind and to put on the new self, created to be like God in true righteousness and holiness.

4:26 — Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry.

4:28 — Anyone who has been stealing must steal no longer.

4:31 — Get rid of all bitterness, rage and anger, brawling and slander, along with every form of malice.

4:32 — Be kind and compassionate to one another, forgiving each other, just as in Christ God forgave you.

5:3 — Among you there must not be even a hint of sexual immorality, or of any kind of impurity, or of greed.

5:4 — Nor should there be obscenity, foolish talk or coarse joking, which are out of place, but rather thanksgiving.

5:8-9 — Walk as children of light, for the fruit of the light consists of all goodness and righteousness and truth.

5:15-16 — Be very careful, then, how you live — not as unwise but as wise; making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil.

5:17 — Do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.

5:18 — Do not get drunk on wine. Instead, be filled with the Spirit.

5:21 — Submit to one another out of reverence for Christ.

5:23-24 — Wives should submit to their husbands in everything, for the husband is the head of the wife.

5:28 — Husbands ought to love their wives as their own bodies.

5:31 — A man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh.

5:33 — The wife must respect her husband.

6:1-3 — Children shall be obedient to their parents in union with the Lord, for this is right; so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth.

6:4 — Fathers, do not exasperate your children; instead, bring them up in the training and instruction of the Lord.

6:13 — Put on the full armour of God, so that when the day of evil comes, you may be able to stand your ground.

6:17 — Take the helmet of salvation and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.

EPISTLE TO THE PHILIPPIANS

1:9 — May your love may abound more and more in knowledge and depth of insight.

2:3 — In humility value others above yourselves.

2:4 — You look out not only for your own interests, but also for the interests of others.

2:15 — May you become blameless and pure, children of God without fault in a warped and crooked generation. Then you will shine among them like stars in the sky.

4:7 — The peace of God will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus.

4:8-9 — Whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable — if anything is excellent or praiseworthy — think about such things. Put them into practice.

4:13 — For all things we must have the strength through the one who gives us power.

EPISTLE TO THE COLOSSIANS

3:2 — Set your minds on things above, not on earthly things.

3:5-6 — Put to death, therefore, whatever belongs to your earthly nature: sexual immorality, impurity, lust, evil desires and greed, which is idolatry. Because of these, the wrath of God is coming.

3:8-9 — You must also rid yourselves of all such things as these: anger, rage, malice, slander, and filthy language from your lips. Do not lie to each other.

3:9-10 — Strip off the old personality. Put on the new self, which is being renewed in knowledge in the image of its Creator.

3:12 — As God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.

3:13 — Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you.

3:14 — Clothe yourselves with love, for it is a perfect bond of union.

3:17 — Whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

3:18 — Wives, submit yourselves to your husbands.

3:19 — Husbands, love your wives and do not be harsh with them.

3:20 — Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord.

3:21 — Fathers, do not embitter your children, or they will become discouraged.

3:23 — Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as

working for the Lord, not for human masters.

4:2 — Devote yourselves to prayer, being watchful and thankful.

4:5 — Live wisely among those who are not believers, and make the most of every opportunity.

4:6 — Let your conversation be gracious and attractive, so that you will have the right response for everyone.

FIRST EPISTLE TO THE THESSALONIANS

4:3-5 — You should avoid sexual immorality. You should learn to control your own body in a way that is holy and honourable, not in passionate lust.

5:8 — Put on faith and love as a breastplate, and the hope of salvation as a helmet.

5:11 — Keep encouraging one another and building one another up.

5:15 — Make sure that nobody pays back wrong for wrong, but always strive to do what is good for each other and for everyone else

5:17 — Pray continually.

5:18 — Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus.

5:19 — Do not put out the fire of the Spirit.

5:21 — Test it all; hold on to what is good.

5:22 — Reject every kind of evil.

SECOND EPISTLE TO THE THESSALONIANS

3:2 — May we be delivered from wicked and evil people, for not everyone has faith.

3:3 — The Lord is faithful, and he will strengthen you and protect you from the evil one.

3:10 — The one who is unwilling to work shall not eat.

FIRST EPISTLE TO TIMOTHY

2:4 — God want all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth.

3:2-4 — The overseer is to be above reproach, faithful to his wife, temperate, self-controlled, respectable, hospitable, able to teach, not given to drunkenness, not violent but gentle, not quarrelsome, not a lover of money. He must manage his own family well and see that his children obey him.

3:11 — The women are to be worthy of respect, not malicious talkers but temperate and trustworthy in everything.

5:1-2 — Do not rebuke an older man harshly, but exhort him as if he were your father. Treat younger men as brothers, older women as mothers, and younger women as sisters, with absolute purity.

5:4 — You should learn to put your religion into practice by caring for your own family and so repaying your parents and grandparents.

5:14 — Younger widows should marry and have children.

6:7 — We brought nothing into the world, and we can take nothing out of it.

6:8 — If we have food and clothing, we will be content with that.

6:10 — The love of money is a root of all kinds of evil. Some people, eager for money, have wandered from the faith and pierced themselves with many griefs.

6:11 — You must pursue righteousness, godliness, faith, love, endurance and gentleness.

6:12 — Fight the good fight of the faith. Take hold of the eternal life to which you were called when you made your good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

6:17 — Do not put your hope in wealth, which is so uncertain. Put your hope in God.

6:18-19 — Be rich in good deeds, and be generous and willing to share, safely treasuring up for yourselves a fine foundation for the future, so that you may get a firm hold on the real life.

SECOND EPISTLE TO TIMOTHY

1:7 — God gave us a Spirit of power, love and self-discipline.

2:15 — Do your best to present yourself to God as one approved.

2:22 — We must pursue righteousness, faith, love and peace, along with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart.

3:1-5 — There will be terrible times in the last days: People will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boastful, proud, abusive, disobedient to their parents, ungrateful, unholy, without love, unforgiving, slanderous, without self-control, brutal, not lovers of the good, treacherous, rash, conceited, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God — having a form of godliness but denying its power. Have nothing to do with such people.

3:16-17 — All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every

good work.

EPISTLE TO TITUS

1:2 — God does not lie.

1:7-9 — An overseer must be blameless, not overbearing, not quick-tempered, not given to drunkenness, not violent, not pursuing dishonest gain. Rather, he must be hospitable, one who loves what is good, who is self-controlled, upright, holy and disciplined. He must hold firmly to the trustworthy message as it has been taught.

2:2 — Teach the older men to be temperate, worthy of respect, self-controlled, and sound in faith, in love and in endurance.

2:3-5 — Teach the older women to be reverent in the way they live, not to be slanderers or addicted to much wine, but to be self-controlled and pure, to be busy at home, to be kind, and to be subject to their husbands, so that no one will malign the word of God.

3:1-2 — Be ready to do whatever is good, slander no one, be peaceable and considerate, and always be gentle towards everyone.

3:5-7 — God saved us because of his mercy. He saved us through the washing of rebirth and renewal by the Holy Spirit, so that, having been justified by his grace, we might become heirs having the hope of eternal life.

EPISTLE TO PHILEMON

1:3 — He who is with the Lord has mercy and peace from him.

EPISTLE TO THE HEBREWS

4:12 — The word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and

spirit; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.

5:9 — Jesus Christ is the source of eternal salvation for all who obey him.

5:13 — Anyone who lives on milk, being still an infant, is not acquainted with the teaching about righteousness.

5:14 — Solid food is for the mature, who by constant use have trained themselves to distinguish good from evil.

10:24-25 — We should spur one another on towards love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, but encouraging one another.

10:26 — If we deliberately keep on sinning after we have received the knowledge of the truth, no sacrifice for sins is left.

11:1 — Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

12:5 — Do not make light of the Lord's discipline, and do not lose heart when he rebukes you.

12:7 — God is treating you as his children. For what children are not disciplined by their father?

12:11 — No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.

13:1-2 — Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it.

13:4 — The marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral.

13:5 — Keep your lives free from the love of money and be

content with what you have.

13:6 — The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?

13:15 — Let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise –the fruit of lips that openly profess his name.

13:16 — Do good and share with others, for with such sacrifices God is pleased.

EPISTLE OF JAMES

1:6 — The one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind.

1:12 — Blessed is the one who perseveres under trial because, having stood the test, that person will receive the crown of life that the Lord has promised to those who love him.

1:15 — After desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin gives birth to death.

1:19 — Everyone should be quick to listen, slow to speak and slow to become angry.

1:20 — Human anger does not produce the righteousness that God desires.

1:22 — Do not merely listen to the word. Do what it says.

1:23-24 — Anyone who listens to the word but does not do what it says is like someone who looks at his face in a mirror and, then goes away and immediately forgets what he looks like.

2:13 — He who does not practice mercy will have his judgment without mercy.

2:14 — If a man claims to have faith, but has no deeds, he will

not be saved.

2:17 — Faith by itself, if it is not accompanied by action, is dead.

2:23 — He who puts faith in God will be called his friend.

3:5-6 — The tongue is a small part of the body, but it makes great boasts. A great forest is set on fire by a small spark. The tongue also is a fire.

3:10 — Out of the same mouth come praise and cursing.

3:17 — The wisdom that comes from heaven is pure, peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere.

4:4 — Friendship with the world means enmity against God.

4:6 — God opposes the proud, but shows favour to the humble.

4:8 — Come near to God and he will come near to you. Wash your hands, you sinners, and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

4:11 — Do not slander one another.

4:12 — Who are you to judge your neighbour?

4:17 — If someone knows how to do what is right and yet does not do it, it is a sin for him.

5:12 — Do not swear — not by heaven or by earth or by anything else. But let your 'Yes' be 'Yes', and let your 'No' be 'No'.

5:16 — Confess your sins to each other and pray for each other so that you may be healed. The prayer of a righteous person is powerful and effective.

FIRST EPISTLE OF PETER

1:3 — Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead.

1:13-14 — With minds that are fully sober, do not conform to the evil desires you had when you lived in ignorance.

1:16 — Be holy, because God is holy.

1:22 — Love one another deeply, from the heart.

1:23 — You have been born again, not of perishable seed, but of imperishable, through the living and enduring word of God.

1:25 — The word of the Lord endures for ever.

2:1 — Rid yourselves of all malice and all deceit, hypocrisy, envy, and slander of every kind.

2:2 — Like newborn babies, crave pure spiritual milk, so that by it you may grow up in your salvation.

2:9 — You must declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.

2:11 — Abstain from sinful desires, which wage war against your soul.

2:16 — Live as free people; live as God's slaves.

2:20 — If you suffer for doing good and you endure it, this is commendable before God.

3:1-4 — Wives, submit yourselves to your own husbands and behave chastely and with deep respect, with a gentle and quiet spirit, which is of great worth in God's sight.

3:7 — Husbands, be considerate as you live with your wives, and treat them with respect as the weaker vessel.

3:8 — Be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble.

3:9 — Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult. Repay evil with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing.

3:10 — Keep their tongue from evil and their lips from deceitful speech.

3:11 — Seek peace and pursue it.

3:17 — It is better to suffer for doing good than for doing evil.

4:2 — Do not live the rest of your earthly life for evil human desires, but rather for the will of God.

4:8 — Love each other deeply, because love covers over a multitude of sins.

4:9 — Offer hospitality to one another without grumbling.

4:11 — If anyone speaks, they should do so as one who speaks the very words of God. If anyone serves, they should do so with the strength God provides, so that in all things God may be praised.

5:6 — Humble yourselves, therefore, under God's mighty hand, that he may lift you up in due time.

5:7 — Cast all your anxiety on him because he cares for you.

5:8 — Be alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion looking for someone to devour.

5:10 — Jesus Christ will restore you and make you strong, firm

and steadfast.

SECOND EPISTLE OF PETER

1:5-7 — Add to your faith goodness; and to goodness, knowledge; and to knowledge, self-control; and to self-control, perseverance; and to perseverance, godliness; and to godliness, mutual affection; and to mutual affection, love.

2:19 — Don't be slave of depravity — for people are slaves to whatever has mastered them.

3:14 — Make every effort to be found spotless, blameless and at peace with God.

FIRST EPISTLE OF JOHN

1:5 — God is light; in him there is no darkness at all.

3:6 — No one who lives in him keeps on sinning. No one who continues to sin has either seen him or known him.

3:8 — The one who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning.

3:10 — Anyone who does not do what is right is not God's child, nor is anyone who does not love their brother.

3:11 — We should love one another.

3:13 — Do not be surprised if the world hates you.

3:14 — Anyone who does not love remains in death.

3:18 — Let us not love with words or speech but with actions and in truth.

4:4 — We are from God.

4:7 — Let us love one another, for love comes from God. Everyone who loves has been born of God and knows God.

4:8 — Whoever does not love does not know God, because God is love.

4:10 — Love is that God loved us and sent his Son as an atoning sacrifice for our sins.

4:12 — We love one another, God lives in us and his love is made complete in us.

4:16 — God is love. Whoever lives in love lives in God, and God in them.

4:18 — There is no fear in love. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.

4:21 — Anyone who loves God must also love their brother.

5:3 — This is love for God: to keep his commands. And his commands are not burdensome.

5:4 — Everyone born of God overcomes the world. This is the victory that has overcome the world — our faith.

5:11-12 — God has given us eternal life, and this life is in his Son. Whoever has the Son has life.

5:17 — All wrongdoing is sin.

SECOND EPISTLE OF JOHN

1:6 — This is love: that we walk in obedience to his commands.
